RULES OF PLAY

We use the FIFA "Laws of the Games," as modified by Cal South, USYSA, and the USSF. For teams playing 7v7, referees have been instructed to use the build-out lines specified by the USSF small-sided standard. No players 10 and under are allowed to directly head the ball.

ANY INTERPRETATION OF THE TOURNAMENT RULES AND RESULTING DECISION IS AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS AND IS FINAL.

CREDENTIALS

US Soccer, USSSA, USYSA, Cal South and US Club Soccer teams: Current have laminated player cards and medical release forms (aka registration form) are required for check-in and games. Medical release forms must have a parent "wet" signature. Coaches must have a USSSA, USYSA/Cal South or US Club Soccer card, as appropriate.

Non- Cal South teams require approval of loan players. AYSO loan players are not permitted. Teams outside of Cal South require approved travel papers. AYSO teams: Current laminated AYSO cards and medical release forms are required for check-in and games. A roster listing AYSO players and coaches, and signed by the AYSO regional commissioner, must be provided at tournament check-in. Loan players from Cal South are permitted and must have a current laminated Cal South card and medical release form. Teams, players, or coaches without proper credentials cannot participate.

3. Game Check-in:

Before Game - All Teams must Check-in at designated field tents at least 15-20 minutes before kickoff time.

You must have:

- All Players
- Player and Coach ID cards
- Game Card

o Game cards for preliminary games are pre-printed with teams, field numbers, and game time. o Please fill in the Date, Time, Field #, and Opponent on the Game Card for playoff games (Consolation, quarter-final, semi-final, and championship).

After each game:

Return to Check-In tent, check the score before signing your game card, and retrieve your Game Card and Player

Cards after every match.

**Note: The player card for any player receiving a red card will be held by the field marshal and you must pick it up

from Tournament HQ **

Information on playoff games will be updated on the tournament website.

HOME TEAM:

The home team is listed first on the schedule and provides 3 game balls. If the teams' jersey colors are too similar, in the opinion of the referee, the home team is required to change jerseys.

SIDELINE POLICY:

The home team sits on the north or west side of the field, and the visiting team sits on the south or east side of the field. Spectators sit on the same side of the field as their team opposite of where the AR is located. (Please see Tournament Rules.)

CODE OF CONDUCT:

We expect coaches, players, and spectators to act appropriately and within the letter and spirit of the Laws of the Game. The coach is ultimately responsible for the conduct of those with the team and Spectators. Those engaging in unacceptable behavior will be asked to leave the tournament and not return. Failure to do so may result in a forfeit of a game for that team, in the sole discretion of the Tournament.

FIELDS: Games will be played at Conejo Creek South Park, Thousand Oaks Community Park, and Wildflower Park.
